



CITYPLACE

- PROFILE:** One of the most inspired and admired mixed-use developments in the nation, the 72-acre CityPlace project in Downtown West Palm Beach opened October 2000. CityPlace is a leading visitor destination in Palm Beach County, and its imaginative architecture, public plazas and destination-retailers have made it a signature of Downtown West Palm Beach. The property has been a remarkable growth catalyst for the entire city, increasing property values and fueling the area's economic engine.
- LOCATION:** Strategically positioned at the intersection of Interstate 95, the major north-south artery in South Florida, and Okeechobee Boulevard, the gateway to the Palm Beaches. Located across from the Palm Beach County Convention Center and the renowned Kravis Center for the Performing Arts in Downtown West Palm Beach.
- DESCRIPTION:** The open-air, Italian-inspired property offers more than 100 shops and dining options for people of all ages and tastes. A restored 1920s church adapted to serve as a multi-purpose cultural center, a 20-screen Muvico cinema complex and IMAX theater, and an Improv Comedy Club are among the many attractions. The property offers a stellar lineup of free weekend entertainment, plus a spectacular show fountain in the center of the main plaza. It is also home to close to 600 private homes, live/work lofts, and luxury condominiums.
- SHOPPING:** Shoppers of every stripe, from casual strollers to dedicated fashionistas, will find something they must have at CityPlace, which features some of the most popular stores in the nation, mixed with local and regional specialty shops. National apparel brands include **Macy's, Anthropologie, Lucky Brand Jeans, Victoria's Secret, Banana Republic, Francesca's Collections, Nine West, BCBG MaxAzria, Gap, Apricot Lane, Justice, Tommy Bahama, Ann Taylor, Gymboree, Cache, Armani Exchange** and more. The tenant list also includes home furnishings and home accessories stores such as **Williams-Sonoma, Restoration Hardware, Pottery Barn** and **The Olive Tap** tasting emporium and gourmet market. For cosmetic needs, CityPlace offers **Sephora, Bath & Body Works, Mango Madness Skincare** and nationally renowned **Anushka Spa, Salon & Cosmedical Centre**, a full-service, 12,000-square-foot spa.
- DINING:** If you work up an appetite while shopping, CityPlace's restaurant and bar collection is unparalleled in South Florida. For dining with a side of entertainment, CityPlace offers the famous **B.B. King's Blues Club**, which features Southern comfort food paired with live music seven days a week, as well as **Taverna Opa** complete with belly dancers and napkin tossing. The famed **Improv Comedy Club**; along with the other dining options include **City Cellar Wine Bar & Grill; Ruth's Chris Steak House; McCormick & Schmick's; The Cheesecake Factory; Il Bellagio; Thai Jo; Blue Martini, Brewzzi; Saito's Japanese Steakhouse; Cheeburger Cheeburger**; and more.

Options for quick bites include **Panera Bread**; the nation's number-one juice bar, **Smoothie King**; and home-grown salad and sandwich stop, **Field of Greens**. For sweet treats, CityPlace offers the Italian market and gelato shop, **ITALY**; cupcake boutique, **Sugar Chef**; the whimsical ice cream and candy shop, **Sloan's**; **Tutti Frutti Frozen Yogurt**; and **Rita's Italian Ice**.

TROLLEY: CityPlace, in a partnership with the West Palm Beach Downtown Development Authority, also operates a free trolley service that links the center with the Clematis District and has more than 50,000 people riding the trolleys each month. This service has, in itself, become a popular tourist attraction, and runs from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. Sunday through Wednesday, and 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. Thursday through Saturday.

HARRIET HIMMEL THEATER: CityPlace's centerpiece – **The Harriet Himmel Theater for the Performing Arts** – is a restored 1920s church, which now hosts a variety of cultural performances, weddings, corporate events, community functions, art exhibits, educational forums and more.

FOUNTAIN: The \$3.5 million, eco-friendly “show” fountain on the plaza dazzles guests with a choreographed performance to music every half-hour and serves as CityPlace's centerpiece. The energy-efficient fountain has 192 50-Watt LED fixtures and a 100 percent chemical-free purifying system, which is environmentally safe. The fully automated water feature is also illuminated in an array of colors.

ENTERTAINMENT: Visitors love the free live music and entertainment in front of the fountain on the CityPlace plaza on weekends all year round, plus marquee cultural events, National Football League entertainment and top national music acts. CityPlace has hosted free, live concerts from musicians such as Vanessa Carlton, Julianne Hough, Clay Walker, Joe Nichols, Plain White T's, Jake Owen, The Script and Colbie Caillat, among others.

PARKING: Covered parking for 3,300 vehicles in four garages, plus a 150-space parking lot on the northern end of the property across, all of which include 24-hour security. Valet parking is available in several locations and private on-site parking is provided for CityPlace residents.
